I understand that the following are biblical principles and conduct endorsed by Grace Baptist Church and Indiana Christian Academy and are expected of me as a student at Indiana Christian Academy.

1. I will seek to protect my mind, body and morals from evil companions by not making them my intimate associates. [James 4:4b]
2. Because of a drastic moral decline in today's entertainment industry, I will try to wisely and conscientiously select the TV programs, and rented or purchased movies that I watch. I will try to turn from those programs that have vulgar jokes and statements, immoral behavior, and activity of which Christ could not approve. The computer and the internet are useful tools, but I will seek to use them only in a way which would be pleasing to the Lord. I also understand that the school encourages students not to go to any movie theater, since the testimony of the school, as well as my own, is at stake. [Psalm 101:3]
3. As a Christian, it is my goal to avoid rock music, rap and any tunes ("Christian" or "secular") that create a reckless spirit, or words set to music that suggest: [Psalm 40:2, 3]
 - a) the occult, Satan worship, the drug culture;
 - b) rebellion;
 - c) living for the thrill of the present without thinking of the consequences;
 - d) living for self, the lust of the flesh (immorality).
4. Because the Christian's body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, I will not participate in smoking, chewing tobacco, dancing, immoral behavior, or the using or handling of drugs which would necessitate immediate dismissal. [I Cor. 6:20]
5. It is "reasonable service" for the Christian to present his/her body a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto the Lord. I will, therefore, seek to faithfully witness as a Christian by looking, acting and talking like a true Christian. [Rom. 12:1, 2]
6. I have read the 2008-09 Student Handbook, and will seek to abide by the rules and policies stated therein.
