

Student's Acceptance of Indiana Christian Academy's Practical Christian Conduct



At Indiana Christian Academy, we understand that we do not have “a corner” on truth nor on the application of truth. It is not our desire to usurp the authority of your home, but we would like to encourage you to follow the rules and guidelines of ICA while at school and when representing the school. ICA believes that there are certain areas of conduct that are clearly spelled out by Scripture and that should be adhered to both at school and home.

1. I will seek to protect my mind, body and morals from evil influences of life and choose not to make them my intimate associates. (James 4:4; 1 Corinthians 15:33)
2. Because of the drastic moral decline in today's entertainment industry, I will try to wisely and conscientiously select the things that I watch. I will try to turn from those programs that have vulgar jokes, immoral behavior, suggestive content, and content that would be inappropriate and not Christ-like. (Psalm 101:3)
3. As a Christian, it is important to avoid music choices that would be inappropriate or against Scripture. Although music preferences differ, it is clear that certain themes and genres are not God-honoring. These music themes we believe that are not God-honoring are:
 - a. Music that involves the occult, Satanic worship, the drug culture;
 - b. Rebellious toward God-given authority;
 - c. Living for the thrill of the present without regard for consequences or pleasing Christ;
 - d. Living for self and the lustful desires of the flesh, including immorality.
4. Because the Christian's body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, I will not participate in smoking, chewing tobacco, alcohol, immoral behavior, or the using or handling of drugs which would necessitate immediate dismissal. (1 Corinthians 6:19, 20)

I understand that the above are Biblical principles and conduct endorsed by Indiana Christian Academy and are expected of me as a student at Indiana Christian Academy. To participate in or discuss at school my participation in the above behaviors, will result in serious discipline measures.
